JAYENDRA - THE HISTORY —

The founder of the Jayendra Group of Institutions, Smt. Dhanalakshmi Jayachandran sought to make education accessible to all sections of the society. It was under her guidance that Sri Jayendra Saraswathy Vidyalaya Matriculation School was set up in 1980.

In the year 1999, an Arts and Science College was started. Sri Jayendra Saraswathy Vidyalaya CBSE School was established in 2012. Presently, Jayendra Group of Institutions has the Matriculation Higher Secondary School and the CBSE Senior Secondary School under its banner.

The Jayendra Group of Institutions is managed by the Sri Jayendra Saraswathy Trust formed in the year 1980 with four trustees. The trust aimed to inculcate our culture, with quality education for the needy children with no capitation or donation. Sri D. Balasundaram was the first chairman of the Sri Jayendra Saraswathy Trust.



He is a renowned industrialist honoured with the “CREATOR OF PROSPERITY” award from Dr A P J Abdul Kalam.

OUR LEGACY —

Sri D. Balasundaram developed India's first electric motor in 1939 in GD Naidu's Workshop. In 1946, he started Textool Co., and manufactured Textile machinery spare parts. In 1948, he made India's first Ring Frame.

Textool Co. had more than 4000 workers in 1956. The Government of India took his help in the manufacture of Sten Guns in 1949 and more than 5000 guns were made. He pioneered the concept of subcontracting and ancillarisation and encouraged many of his employees and associates to start their own ventures to produce components, thus paving a way for the development of industry in the Coimbatore region.

He has been a monumental support to his daughter-in-law Smt. Dhanalakshmi Jayachandran in the establishment of the educational institutions.

Grades 1 and 2

The first two years of formal schooling is a transition time and our primary focus is to develop the 'LSRW' skills and basic arithmetic skills. We recognize their individuality and focus on their strengths by using the Multiple Intelligence theory of Howard Gardner. We incorporate Jolly Phonics and Jolly Grammar into their curriculum to enhance the skills of reading and interpreting.

Grades 3 to 5

We follow the CBSE syllabus with XSEED Curriculum, the 3 language systems with SEL, Yoga and Value Education. We also provide Performing Arts, Cubs and Bulbuls, Silambam and Dance. The clubs include Dramatics Club, Quiz club, Art and Craft club, Eco Club and Math club. We have also included a special pilot course on Financial Study for grade IV. Grades

6 to 8 The students are encouraged to pursue their academic interests at an advanced level. Skills like critical thinking and creativity are given paramount importance. The students will be able to gauge the potential challenges and offer possible solutions.

Students can become members of the Communication Skills Club, Quiz Club, Photography Club and Environment Club. They can also choose to be a part of Scouts and Guides, Silambam and the school band. The students of Grade 8 are also given the opportunity to join the Air Wing of NCC.

Grades 9 and 10

We attach equal importance to both academic and non-academic pursuits. Work education is made mandatory for all the students of grades 9 and 10. This allows students to an additional subject along with the 5 core subjects.

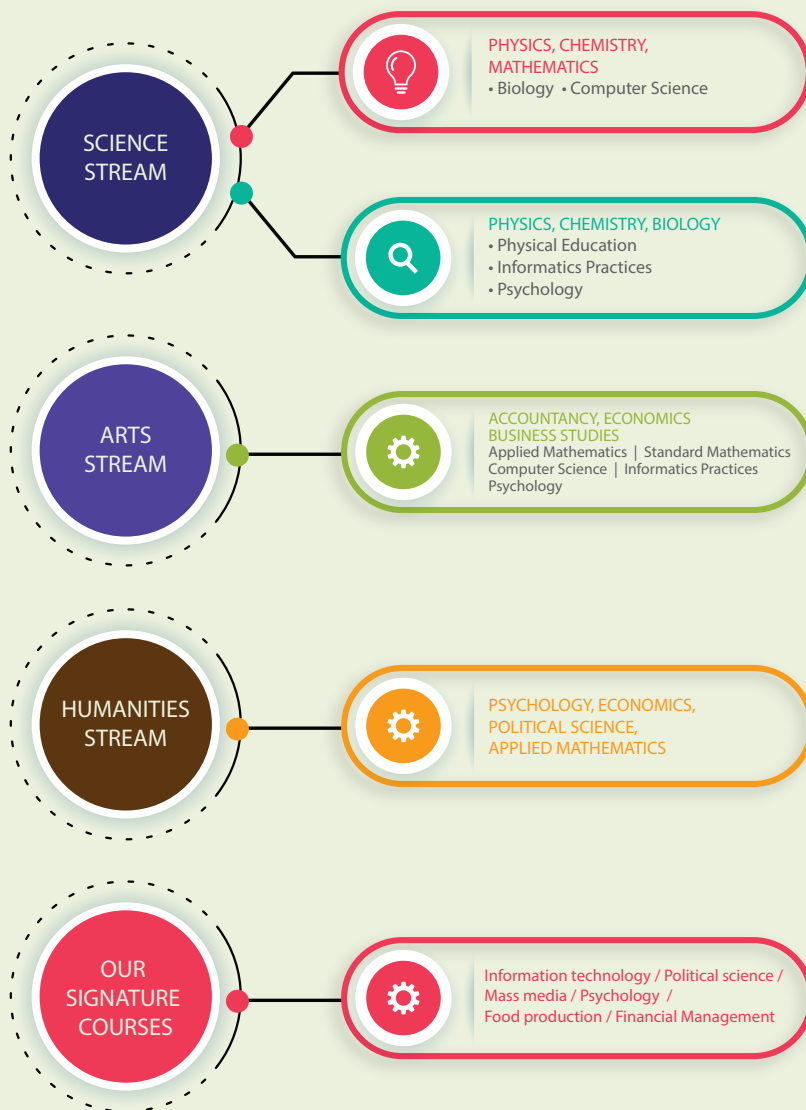
Grades 11 and 12

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SCHOOL UNIFORM

- The students are expected to wear their regular school uniform along with their ID cards from Monday to Friday.
- Sports uniform should be worn as per instructions of the PT master.
- Primary upwards girls should wear black bloomers along with their uniforms.
- Any extra attire beyond uniforms-including jewellery, sunglasses, hats, scarves, bandanas, stocking/skull caps, sweatbands, long earrings, chains, pendants, rings or bracelets, fancy/expensive watches, bangles etc., will not be permitted.
- No fancy hairstyles will be tolerated. Colouring of hair is strictly prohibited.
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
- Girls may wear small studs.
- Girls may use black coloured rubber bands, ribbons, hairpins or clips for their hair.
- It is compulsory that every student come to school in their prescribed uniform, including badge and belt, failing which they may be sent home. Untidy dresses, being unwashed, unbuttoned shirts, and untucked shirts will face serious consequences.
- It is absolutely imperative that only English be the mode of communication within school premises, exempting their second and third language classes.
- Students should attend the morning assembly without fail.
- It is essential that students stand up when a teacher enters the classroom and wish them accordingly.
- Every student should bring with him/her their text books and note books required for the day. Other than the prescribed books, no books shall be brought to school.
- Home assignments should be done neatly and regularly and submitted on or before the due date.
- Students must follow Reduce, Reuse and Recycle policy and support to promote a Clean Earth concept.
- Students should be polite, courteous to everyone and show due respect to all elders and authorities. They should address teachers politely, using appropriate terms of courtesy. They must stand when addressed by and when addressing all elders.
- Students are prohibited from wearing gold jewellery while at school.
- Attendance on National days like Independence Day, and Republic Day is compulsory.

STUDENTS

- Every child should bring their school diary to class every day.
- Students in possession of any tobacco, pan masala or chewing gums will be expelled.
- Gadgets of any form will not be entertained on the school premises.
- As the age limit does not permit a license for two-wheelers, students are not allowed to ride two-wheelers to school.
- School property must be safeguarded by all the students, damaging school property may result in suspension or expulsion.
- Rough handling of library books, careless attitude in the laboratory and general untidiness are objectionable, punishable and forbidden.

ADMISSION REGULATIONS

Minimum age for admission

LKG: Children completing 3 years and 6 months as of the first of April of the year of application can seek admission.

UKG TO GRADE XII:

The school will consider for admission, subject to the availability of seats to pupil from all schools, recognized by the Central Board or the State Board on the production of transfer certificate duly issued by competent officers of the education department. The application should also satisfy the requirement of the CBSE board for CBSE admission.
